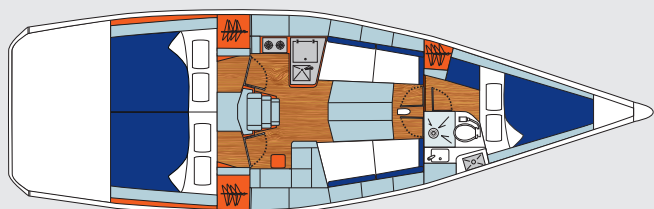


SUNSAIL MATCH FIRST 40

In addition to the standard specifications, the Match First 40 comfortably houses a roomy interior with electric heads and central heating. It has 8 berths but can be sailed or raced with a further 4 crew members on board during the day.

Each yacht is coded to MCA Cat level 2 and will have all safety kit required, including life jackets, first aid kits etc.
